### ISM FAITHFUL SERVICE RECOGNITION — FULL AWARD CRITERIA

Nominees should embody one or more of the following:

- A. Faithful, Consistent Service
- steady dedication to ministry
- supports spiritual and pastoral needs of others
- serves with integrity and humility
- B. Compassion Toward the Marginalized
- ministry to homeless, sick, imprisoned, refugees, homebound
- models the compassion of Christ
- C. Sacramental Presence
- celebrates sacraments reverently
- ensures access to sacramental care for underserved populations
- D. Community Building
- fosters healthy relationships, parish life, small communities
- strengthens unity within or across jurisdictions
- E. Hidden or Unrecognized Service
- serves quietly behind the scenes
- embodies "faithfulness in small things"
- F. Contribution to the Mission of the ISM
- evangelization, catechesis, outreach, pastoral care
- strengthens integrity and public witness of the ISM
- G. Personal Virtues
- humility
- compassion
- spiritual maturity
- openness to ongoing conversion and formation
- consistency and integrity in ministry

- 3. A 500-1,000 word description of ministry and impact
- 4. Nominator's contact information
